Post Op Instructions

Verruca Vulgaris (Wart)

- The treated area may throb or ache for a few hours after treatment
- You may develop a blister at the treated area, which is an expected reaction after treatment.
 - You may pop the blister with a sterile needle, but do not pull off the skin. The skin will act as a natural band-aid
- As the wart begins to heal, it may turn purple or black, which signifies that the skin has died and will fall off. This is an expected reaction after treatment.
